## Poster.

The poster introduces lots of **Messy** themes.

**Charles Messier**, 1730 -1817– Astronomer and comet hunter. Responsible for cataloguing 110 objects that could be mistaken for comets - Messier objects.

Central figure with telescope is Messier, wearing his Cross of the Legion of Honour Award.

The eleven bright stars with trails, and two more hidden in the comet trail could represent the 13 comets he discovered.

The building behind and above him in the poster is part of the Musée de Cluny in Paris, formerly the Hotel de Cluny. In the 18<sup>th</sup> century Messier used the tower of the hotel as an observatory. The balcony design is repeated at the bottom of the poster

**Olivier Messiaen**, 1908 -1992 - Composer, organist and ornithologist. In 1931 he became organist at Église de la Sainte-Trinité, Paris, a post he held for more than 61 years. The vaulted ceiling and stained glass windows shown in the poster are from this church.


**Lionel Messi**, 1987 – Professional footballer, Barcelona and Argentina no10.

## Festive Message.

The spectrograph windows are a depiction of the 2nd verse of Deck the Halls, with the spectrum colours representing the pitch and length of the notes of the music.

The altered words of Verse 2, lines 3 and 4 give the festive message.

The first words of verse 2 “See the flowing bowl before us” seem to describe the golden bowl of overflowing coins on the poster.

(The key is F Major, the + sign placed where Bb is raised a semitone to B)

## **Timeline to finding the Treasure Box.**

Taken from our Club Forum, a timeline of some of the key discoveries that led us to the treasure location, in a rather messy fashion!

### **Friday 15<sup>th</sup> December 2017**

- 16:00** – The puzzle starts....printers are switched on! !
- 16:17** – Steve assembles the first composite picture of the 12 pages manually
- 16:57** – Begin to find hexagon images – Ninevah stained glass window
- 17:08** – Sharon solves the Minesweeper game/wordsearch. GAY + GOPHER = **GEOGRAPHY**
- 17:19** – Nick thinks that the blue-bordered images look like photos to the treasure site
- 17:34** – Discover that the blue-bordered pictures all contain anagrams of towns along the river Mess, Luxembourg – this gives the order to put these images in.
- 18:43** – Discover that all the birds are from Messiaen’s “Catalogue d’Oiseaux”
- 20:43** – Gisela finds the first French Heraldic Arms, Avignon
- 21:40** – Jo assembles composite picture on computer.
- 22:25** – Number the hexagons in the order that Mr Messy’s pink line goes through them.

### **Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2017**

- 04:19** – Karen discovers the Arabic writing is Al Mayadin, a town in Syria, and that the grey outline map (hexagon edged) is roughly the shape of Syria.
- 09:00** – Gisela suggests the birds facing left and right could be an Atbash cipher.
- 09:50** – Steve finds message from the comet date line on page 7. **PUB PALATABLE BUT SUGGEST GET TABLE**
- 10:15** – Steve prints off second set of pages and begins cutting out the 65 hexagons.
- 11:40** – Gisela finds the last French Heraldic Arms, Messimy
- 13:28** – Roger spots heraldic message from letters around map of France  
**HERALDRY OF GAUL BEGOT TOO FROM ARMORIAL FRAGMENTS ROUND PERIMETER**
- 13:32** – Discover that this Heraldry sentence is an anagram of 13 words /abbreviations from the heraldic fragments of each of the 12 French towns plus one mystery town.
- 14:54** – Find missing coat of Arms is MESSING, with associated word **TREASURE!**  
Almost a month earlier on 17<sup>th</sup> Nov, Gisela had proposed Messing as a possible location.

**18:09** – Karen solves Messiah puzzle. **HELP LIONEL RE-ARM REBELS**

**18:44** – Gisela finds “Publications of the Astronomical Society of the Pacific.” The Tables used to solve the code words on the 8th blue-edged picture.

**18:20** – Jo and Karen find Messi/Syria/rebels connection with Addounia TV channel.

**20:32** – Begin trying to solve postcard messages.

**21:01** – Steve suggests that The Match of the Day theme tune be used in a similar way to Deck the Halls from the poster, using the spectrum colours.

**21:25** – Karen and Pete confirm the 8<sup>th</sup> blue-edged picture codes are astronomical coordinates of Messier objects.

**21:40** – Steve starts fitting hexagons into map of Syria.

### **Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> December 2017**

**01:15** – Steve successfully places hexagons into map of Syria.

**11:20** – Find enough hexagon images to make a guess at the first message:  
**HAPPY XMAS EPIC NEW YEAR SORTIE FIXING MESS. LUCK AND LOVE FROM BRUCE HINDSIGHT**

**13:30** – Nick (and Mary) make first visit to Messing. Find locations of the first 6 blue-edged pictures on route into Conyfield Wood. Notice the fallen tree and lots of bird boxes in the trees around the pond. Nick even searches the fallen tree, but misses finding the box!

**17:58** – Karen suggests postcard message #8 (page 8) is from ET - **ALIEN**

**21:30** – Pete suggests Hercules and The Hydra, 2<sup>nd</sup> labour, for postcard message #7 - **HERO**

**22:43** – Gisela finds Mr Tidy and Mr Neat from the Mr Messy story, hexagons #24 and #42

**23:17** – Nick finds Madame Adolphine cartoon character, hexagon #19

### **Monday 18<sup>th</sup> December 2017**

**04:38** – Karen suggests postcard message #6 is about Roo and Eeyore in N. Pole Expotition

**04:52** – Karen suggests postcard message #10 is to do with Emmy Noether

**08:55** – Solve message from bird sequence **ADD SENDER TO STAMP**

**11:13** – Bird code confirms the letters obtained from the bird stamps on the postcards

**12:36** – Peter confirms Syria map of hexagons is a unique solution.

13:39 – Have four senders' names for postcards. Hercules, Roo, Elliott and Einstein

13:57 – Begin to see snippets of sentences in Syria hexagon map.  
EACH PIECE MISSING ORDER – MAP OF SKY – NUMBER

16:42 – Karen proposes Earhart as the sender of postcard message #2, with **FLIER** as the clue.

23:56 – Gisela proposes J R Smith to Obama for postcard message #9

23:56 – With just 7 senders' names on the postcards, and some not confirmed, Gisela proposes that the sentence derived from Sender + Stamp is **IN FALLEN TREE**

### Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2017

00:04 – Nick says, "You can't miss the fallen tree from the pond, it was the first place I searched, but I could do a thorough search next time I go"

10:27 – Nick sets off on second trip to Messing

11:45 – Nick finds treasure box in the fallen tree.

**We get Ticket no 1!**

Picture of M1, the Crab Nebula, on the ace of spades.



16:20 – Steve finds Match of the Day sequence through the Syria hexagon map to give second message

**EACH P IS MAP OF SKY EACH PIC IS MESSIER SO NUMBER IN A TIDY INCREASING ORDER.**

17:04 – Interpret this message as: Each page is a map of the sky, with the stars represented by the brown stain blots, and each hexagon is a Messier object. Start looking for Messier objects.

19:34 – Discover all sky maps and all 65 Messier objects.

Get third message from a "tidy increasing order" of Messier objects M1...M110

**FIND AN ESSEX PLACE AMID EVERY EIGHTH BOX IN SYRIA.**

**GO W FROM CH TURN L PICK UP MESS**

19:40 – Every 8<sup>th</sup> letter of the Match of the day sequence spells **MESSING !!**

20:34 – Get message from 8<sup>th</sup> blue-edged picture. **IN A TREE CLEFT**

### Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> December 2017

11:44 – Pete suggests the postcard face pictures link with Messiaen's "Des Canyons aux Étoiles"

17:19 – Pete finds Messiaen's musical alphabet – Steve and Pete solve the 4 pieces of music. They are all from a preface to Messiaen's 7<sup>th</sup> movement of "Quatuor pour la fin du temps"

17:38 – Pete finds Bharata to Rama story – postcard message #4 - **BRO**thers

We start thinking that recipients' names will also give a word/phrase

### Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2017

15:36 – Pete proposes **INTERVERSION** as word from recipients' initial letters.

15:36 – Pete confirms Ribbentrop as recipient of Lady Astor's postcard message #3

15:50 – Pete finds Gene Vidal is recipient of Amelia Earhart's postcard message #2

15:54 – Discover information about Messiaen's use of **INTERVERSION** in his music.

16:10 – Pete sees that the page order of the postcard faces can be changed using the Interversion permutation used in Messiaen's 4<sup>th</sup> movement in "Quatre Études de Rythme"

18:13 – Pete finds postcard message #11 is from Laboa to Noriega – **MGR** = Monsignor

### Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017

23:26 – Pete proposes Phillip Sidney as recipient of postcard message #5

### Monday 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018

13:10 – Peter finds confirmation that **EARL** Leicester is the sender of postcard message #5

### Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2018


12:18 – Peter proposes Queen Eleni as the recipient of postcard message #1.  
Sender is Pêro da Colvihã. Can't find a positive **DOM** link.

### Monday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2018

14:09 – Nick finds the Elephant hexagon image is a detail from a stained glass window.  
Discover thematic link to Messing All Saints Church through Abraham van Linge. This also gives the thematic link for the Nineveh hexagon stained glass window.

### Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2018

22:17 – Steve finds the Fingerprint image is from the opening pages of the Mr Messy book!



# The Main Hunt:

The following is our account of the logical order to untangle the Mess, solve the puzzles and reach the treasure location.

## Mr. Messy pink line route through 65 hexagon pictures.

With no questions this year, the first message comes from identifying the images in the hexagons. After assembling the 12 pages correctly, the overall picture shows a single continuous route from Mr. Messy to the final 65<sup>th</sup> treasure chest hexagon.


The initial letters of the names of these hexagon items spell out the message:

**HAPPY XMAS, EPIC NEW YEAR SORTIE FIXING MESS. LUCK AND LOVE FROM BRUCE HINDSIGHT**

**Note:** Using the double S from Salm-Salm, makes this read slightly better:  
Happy Xmas, Epic New Year's Sortie fixing Mess. Luck and love from Bruce Hindsight.

Each picture has a connection to a **MESS** theme.

- A. Messier – Charles Messier, astronomer
- B. Messiaen – Olivier Messiaen, composer, organist, ornithologist.
- C. Messi – Lionel Messi, footballer
- D. Messines – Battle of Messines, 7<sup>th</sup> June 1917. (19 mines detonated)
- E. Mess - General group with words that start with Mess (many in German!)

## Dominos puzzle

In the bottom right corner of the assembled pages (page 4) is a composite picture of three popes next to a picture of the DVD cover of the TV thriller Messiah.

These are read together as "Pope's Messiah". This is a clue to Messiah, a poem by Alexander Pope.

The first line of the poem is disguised in a block text.



Using the poem as a book code the dominos spell out a message.

Each domino represents a new line in the poem, with the rotated dominos representing the start of new words. The pips on the dominos give the word/letter to extract from each line.

The highlighted red letter and the red domino, specify the letter 'h' in Nymphs.




The dominos give the message: **HELP LIONEL REARM REBELS**

This is referring to the Syrian TV channel Addounia's claim that the way Lionel Messi and his teammates moved across the pitch during the build up to a goal showed the route that rebels could smuggle guns into Syria.

On the composite puzzle picture is a grey outline map of Syria. According to the Addounia commentator, the move was started by Messi as he crossed into Syria at Homs. Homs is depicted by the AK-47 rifle on the map. The Arabic town named on the map is Al Mayadin, where the rebel arms shipment was apparently destined for, as indicated by the goal scored at the end of the move. The move also involved Iniesta, who is pictured in hexagon #28.



## Fitting the 65 hexagons into the map of Syria.

The 65 hexagons all fit into the outline map of Syria. Start by placing the red edged GOAL hexagon on Al Mayadin, and the blue edged MESSI hexagon on the AK-47 symbol.

It is now possible to fit in all the remaining 63 hexagons, in a unique arrangement, so that adjacent coloured edges always match.



## Match of the Day route through Syria

In the middle of the grey map of Syria is a picture of a TV with 'Match of the Day' written on the screen. Starting at the MESSI hexagon the tune can be played out, with the spectrum coloured edges of the hexagons representing the notes of the song, following a twisting route that ends on the GOAL hexagon. The key is A major.

Using the initial letters from the names of the hexagon pictures, a second message is spelt out.




**Note:** Messi's thought bubble, the picture of the TV inside the map, and the grey dotted line joining the Xylophone hexagon to the map are all clues to use the Match of the Day theme tune to find a route through Syria, using the spectrum colours.



# Twelve Maps of the sky.

Interpreting the message from the Match of the Day route through Syria tells us that each page (p) of the hunt is a map of the sky, and that each picture hexagon (pic) is a Messier object. Further research shows that all the brown messy stains on the pages represent stars in that part of the sky, larger blots for brighter stars. The map below shows the approximate superimposed position of the 12 pages. Putting the Messier objects into “a tidy increasing order” gives a third message from the hexagon letters.



'Mess' refers to the 8 blue-edged pictures, which all contain anagrams of towns along the river Mess in Luxembourg. The 9<sup>th</sup> blue-edged picture is a map of the river Mess with the positions of the eight towns shown with red dots. This gives the correct order of the pictures.

Going west from the church in Messing, take the left turn into School Road.  
The first 6 photographs show features along the route to the site in Conyfield Wood.

1. Christmas wreath on house.
2. Footpath sign.
3. Old fence/gate into wood.
4. Tree.
5. Blue post.
6. Pond.

On reaching the pond, the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> blue-edged pictures pinpoint the exact hiding place of the treasure box.

**Note:** Around the pond in Conyfield Wood there are numerous bird boxes in the trees. This is perhaps a confirmer to the use of the bird code in the 7<sup>th</sup> blue-edged picture.

## Messiaen's Birds.


All the birds shown along the wavy line ending on the 7<sup>th</sup> blue-edged picture are one of 13 birds from the "Catalogue d'oiseaux" (Catalogue of birds), a work by Olivier Messiaen.

The two Alpine choughs facing each other with an ellipsis between them, is a clue that these images represent the letters A to Z.

As there are 13 birds in the Catalogue, they can be given the letters A - M when facing right, and Z - N when facing left. (Atbash code)

This is the key to the Bird Code.



This is referring to the 12 postcards, one on each page, that all have stamps depicting one of the same birds from Messiaen's Catalogue of Birds.



# French Heraldry.

On each page there is a postcard back, which has a bird stamp with a franking mark.


The franking marks on the stamps are a hexagon, oval or square shape, and these correspond to the symbols that represent towns, marked on the map of France on page 5.

The blue, white and red symbols match the colours of the French flag.

By orientating the map to north, and then reading clockwise around the circle of letters, a message is revealed, starting on the H and reading every other letter.

## HERALDRY OF GAUL BEGOT TOO FROM ARMORIAL FRAGMENTS ROUND PERIMETER

Each town has its Heraldic Arms broken down into component parts around the circle.



The twelve French towns on the map all have a Mess connection.

Each town's component parts of their Arms match to letters on the perimeter circle. Starting on the background shield, they spell out: (mainly going clockwise, some are anagrams)

These 12 words/abbreviations are clues to solving who the sender of the postcard is.



The remaining component parts on the circle make up the Arms of the village of Messing in Essex. The associated word from the perimeter circle of letters is **TREASURE**.

**Note:** Also on the map of France is a minesweeper game mine, which represents the site of the Battle of Messines 1917.

## Postcard Messages.

The postcard backs each have a written message. The **From:** and **To:** suggest we have to discover who the sender and recipient are. These are very tricky tasks, made even harder as they seem to have no Mess connection, and also have no connection to each other.

The only further clue is the word or abbreviation gained from the Heraldic Arms of the 12 towns, presumably from where the postcard is sent. To start with any of the four grouped words could go with any of the four matching franking marks on the postcards.

Using the Bird Code letters, each stamp can be given a letter. The instruction from the bird sequence was ADD SENDER TO STAMP, and by adding the initial letter of the sender to the stamp letter gives a new sum for each page. In page order these say **IN FALLEN TREE**

This is the answer to the 7<sup>th</sup> blue-edged picture. The treasure box is hidden in a very prominent fallen tree near to the pond in Conyfield Wood, Messing.



In this order, the initial letters of the postcard recipients spell **INTERVERSION**

Interversion is a method that Messiaen used to add mathematical permutations to music. In the 4<sup>th</sup> movement of "Quatre Études de Rythme" he repeatedly uses the same permutation to produce new orderings of the notes in a cyclic pattern.

As well as a comment about The Crown pub in Messing, this is a hint to solving the code on the final picture clue along the river Mess route into the wood.




## 8<sup>th</sup> Blue-Edged Picture Along The Mess.

This final clue uses a set of tables from the "Publications of the Astronomical Society of the Pacific", Volume VIII, p 109 to encode coordinates of objects in the sky.

The R.A. (Right Ascension) and N.P.D. (North Polar Distance) are listed in code. From the tables in the publication these code words can be changed back into numbers, and converted into R. Ascension (hours:mins) and Declination (degrees:minutes)

These astronomical coordinates are all Messier objects, and using the letters from the corresponding Messier hexagons (from the star maps) a final message is revealed. The final letter T from M86 is the T from the Treasure Chest hexagon.

**IN A TREE CLEFT**

The treasure box is hidden in a cleft in the fallen tree.

## Messiaen's Musical Alphabet

The four pieces of music on pages 1,7,9 and 10 are a substitution code using Messiaen's Musical Alphabet as the key. <http://in.music.sc.edu/fs/bain/soundingnumber/tracks/languageoftheangels.html>

The first piece on page 1 is titled "Nieve O. Serialism", an anagram of "Olivier Messiaen".



The pieces decode to:

Arcs-en-ciel = Rainbows

Épées de Feu = Swords of fire

Fouillis = Mess

Brusques Étoiles = Sudden Stars



These words come from a preface to Messiaen's 7<sup>th</sup> movement in "Quatuor pour la fin du temps". Messiaen wrote the piece whilst a prisoner of war during WW2 in Görlitz camp.

Fouillis is connected to the tangle of Mr Messy's pink line

Brusques Étoiles is connected to the comet date line – sudden stars are comets

# Minesweeper & Wordsearch

Solving the minesweeper game on page 7, gives the positions of nine mines, as indicated by the top left-hand red number.

The top right-hand red number, 310, alludes to the time of 3:10am on the 7th June 1917, when the mines used in the Battle of **Messines** were detonated.

Overlaying this 8 x 8 grid onto the 8 x 8 Wordsearch grid on page 6, shows the nine mines over the letters G A Y G O P H E R. Using the + symbol this reads as GAY + GOPHER.



This is an anagram of **GEOGRAPHY**.

The evening before the 7<sup>th</sup> June attack General Sir Charles Harington said to the press “Gentlemen, I don’t know whether we are going to make history tomorrow, but at any rate we shall **change geography**”.


There is a minesweeper mine symbol on the map of France on page 5, showing the location of this battle in Belgium.

The background map used for the word search grid is square 21 from a planning map of the Battle of Messines.

The German word for Ordnance survey map is **Messtischblatt**.

There is a grey dotted line connecting this wordsearch grid to the Jeanne Loriod hexagon, together with a mine/key symbol. That hexagon is also M20, the Trifid nebula. Trifid means ‘divided into three lobes’



We believe that there is another message to be found from this wordsearch grid and that this mine/key symbol is a clue to that.

We have tried amending the wordsearch grid using the mine count numbers (0,1,2,3) and then using Jeanne Loriod as a key.

We also note that the + symbol is placed on the 21<sup>st</sup> square of the grid (background map is square 21).

In this puzzle on page 12, the Team symbols relate to the five main Mess themes.



In the Document Properties of the hunt PDF, the title is listed as (7,4,4).

This is in the form of a crossword clue length.

If there is a method in the hunt to discover this name we have not found it.




## Miscellany.

1. The face picture of the card we picked up from the treasure box differs slightly from the poster. The top heading has been removed revealing 3 more stars with trails.
2. The 12 Messier objects listed in encoded astronomical coordinates on the 8<sup>th</sup> blue-edged card, can be joined together on the star map to make a drawing of a 5-pointed star with tails!

On our second trip to the site, we also looked for comets!



3. The overall shape of the assembled 12 pages looks a bit like a Christmas tree on its side. This is possibly a hint at the fallen tree.
